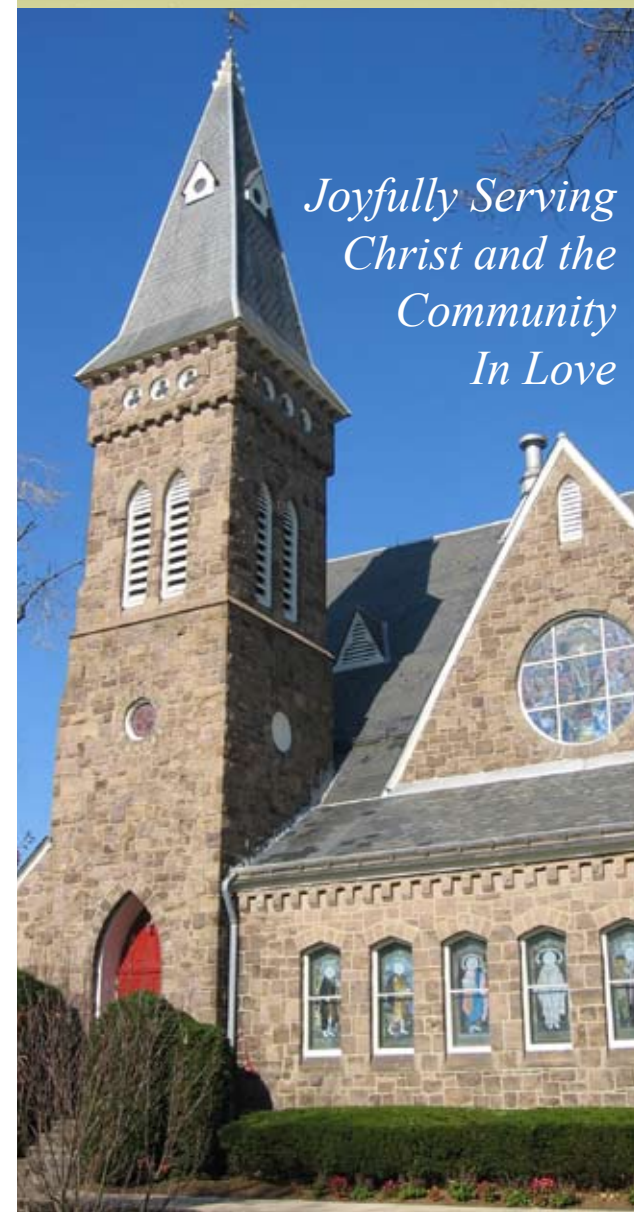

Fellowship

Fellowship time is held weekly in Fellowship Hall between Sunday services; a perfect time to meet members, long-time and new. Other opportunities that enhance the lives of members and friends include:

- Youth Fellowship--junior and senior highs
 - Women's Association
 - Softball Team
- Annual Strawberry Festival
- Chicken Barbeque dinners
 - Lenten soup suppers

Outreach

Our congregation supports and is committed to a variety of ministries locally, nationally and world-wide, including:

- Volunteers in Mission (VIM), for which we send 60 youth and adult volunteers each summer to Maine to work on construction projects

for neighbors in need and to teach Bible school

- Flemington Area Food Pantry
- Habitat for Humanity
- CROP Walk
- Interfaith Hospitality Network, which provides food, shelter and guidance resources to homeless women, children and families
- A week-long Vacation Bible School in the summer, open to children throughout our community

Education

- Sunday school classes for two-year-olds through senior-high ages during the first service
- Bible study and other adult education classes are offered throughout the year.
- Our Nursery School is open to all three-, four- and five-year-old children in our community. Directed by fully-certified teachers, it offers children experiences based upon sound principals of Christian and early childhood education.

Music

Our church has a long tradition of musical excellence. The music ministry provides a wide selection of music for all age groups through its vocal and handbell choirs including:

- Chancel Choir (adults)
- Youth Choir (grades 7-12)
- Children's Choir (grades 2-6)
- Memorial Ringers (adults)
- Joyful Ringers (grades 9-12)
- Melody ringers (grades 5-8)
 - Melody Chimes
- Soloists and instrumentalists

Central to the music program is the 3-manual Austin pipe organ (1916, restored 1970) which leads the congregational singing and accompanies the choirs.
